CAFE SCHOLARSHIP

The Canutillo Alumni Foundation for Education "CAFE" would like to award scholarships to Canutillo High School and Northwest Early College High School Seniors interested in pursuing a college degree at any university of their choice.

The deadline for submitting the application is no later than **4 p.m., May 6, 2019**, to the Public Information Officer, at the Administration Facility, 7965 Artcraft. A copy of the student's high school transcript must be attached to the application.

All applicants will be scored using the following criteria:

- Financial Need
- Grade point average of at least 2.6 on a scale of 4.0
- Scholarship Application Form
- Show interest in attending a university or community college
- Attach a 250 word typed essay explaining your career goal, why you should be awarded the scholarship and how a college education will help improve the Canutillo Community.
- Attach a full résumé

In order to be considered for a scholarship, all required documents must be turned in by the deadline (*scholarship application form, 250 word essay, résumé, and student high school transcript*).

Finalists for the scholarships will be contacted to schedule an interview with the scholarship committee. Students selected to receive the scholarship will be notified personally of their selection.

CLASS OF '94 SCHOLARSHIP

As proud Eagles who want to see a new generation soar to new heights, Canutillo alumni have always provided support for Canutillo students and their families. This belief is the foundation of the Canutillo tradition of giving back to our community.

The Class of 1994 has established a \$1,000 scholarship for Canutillo graduates who plan on pursuing their dreams of higher education. Their generous award will be given to one bright Canutillo graduating senior who meets the following criteria:

- Student must have a parent who is a Canutillo alumnus.
- Student must be the first generation of his or her family to attend college, university, or vocational school (preferred but not mandatory).
- Student must provide an acceptance letter from a college, university, or vocational school.
- Student must have a declared major.
- Student must provide letter of recommendation (teacher, school staff, priest, pastor, etc.)
- Student must have between a 2.0 – 4.0 GPA
- Student must write a 500 word essay on how he or she would use his or her education and career to improve our community.
