Components

- 4 components of NBC
 - Component 1: Content Exam
 - Component 2: Differentiation of Instruction
 - Component 3: Teaching Practice and Learning Environment
 - Component 4: Reflective and Effective Practitioner

Component 1: Content Exam

- Every content has their own exam of 2 parts
 - MCQ (timed)
 - FRQ (timed)

Component 2: Differentiation of Instruction

- Written responses from students for multiple assignments
- Analyze certain students work over the multiple assignments
- Answer questions about how they learned and your lesson planning process.
- ~15 pages written commentary + Images

Component 3: Teaching Practice and Learning Environment

- Video tape yourself teaching 2 lessons
- Analyze how you interacted with students and why
- Answer questions about how they learned and your lesson planning process.
- ~15 pages written commentary + Images

Component 4: Reflective and Effective Practitioner

- Describe and analyze how you create a classroom community
- Describe and analyze how you create lessons, decide on what material to focus on, grade to help students learn
- Describe and analyze how you help the school and community
- ~25 pages written commentary + Images

How long is this going to take?

- Campbell's Recommendation
 - Year 1: Comp 1 & Comp 3
 - Year 2: Comp 2 & Comp 4 (begin planning 4 EARLY)
- Dr. Muir's Talk
 - The 1 Year Plan

Time commitment: Around 25-50 hours for Comp 2,3,4

How much does it cost?

- \$75 fee registration/year
- \$475/component = \$1900 for all 4 components

Additional Costs:

- \$475 to redo components if failed
- \$125 to redo parts of the Comp 1: Content Exam

Why should I do it?

- State Funding
 - Automatically TIA Tier 1 (\$3000-9000 depending title 1 on campus)
