CISD Local Policy DH - EMPLOYEE STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

ARREST AND CONVICTIONS

An employee who is arrested for any felony or any offense involving moral turpitude must report the arrest to the principal or immediate supervisor within three calendar days of the arrest. An employee who is convicted of or receives deferred adjudication for such an offense must also report that event to the principal or immediate supervisor within three calendar days of the event.

A supervisor or principal shall notify the Department of Human Resources of any or conviction within five calendar days of receipt of such information.

MORAL TURPITUDE

Moral turpitude includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Dishonesty; fraud; deceit; theft; misrepresentation;
- 2. Deliberate violence
- 3. Base, vile, or depraved acts that are intended to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of the actor;
- 4. Felony possession, transfer, sale, distribution, or conspiracy to possess, transfer, sell or distribute any controlled substance defined in Chapter 481 of the Health and Safety Code; acts constituting public intoxication, operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, disorderly conduct if two or more acts are committed within any 12 month period; or
- 5. Acts constituting abuse under the Texas Family Code.
