Gifted and Talented Kindergarten Screening

Dear Kindergarten Parent,

## The Texas State Plan for Gifted and Talented Education requires districts to screen all kindergarten students for gifted and talented services.

Canutillo ISD asks its kindergarten teachers to complete an observation form for each of their students in March. This observation form highlights areas that **may** indicate gifted potential.

Upon review of the observation form, qualifying students will begin GT testing. **Typically, about 5% of students qualify for gifted testing**. You will be notified if that is the case for your child. We will not administer tests to your child without your permission. *If your child does not qualify this year, they can be nominated for testing in the spring of their first grade year*. Nomination forms are available at your school.

Testing for gifted and talented services include a non-verbal assessment, an achievement test, a parent questionnaire, and all academic data that is available. Kindergarten students who qualify for GT services will participate in a GT pull-out program in first grade.

Our GT pull-out program allows students to participate in research and project based activities that enhance the information they receive from their regular teacher. Twice a week they will spend 45 minutes with a qualified GT teacher completing rigorous work that supports their academic growth.
